- 4. The deposit (£500) for each candidate may be paid by cash or bank transfer (BACS). Bank details are obtainable from the (Acting) Returning Officer.
- 5. If any election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday 4 July 2024**.
- 6. Applications to register to vote must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by midnight on **Tuesday 18 June 2024**. Applications can be made online at: https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote
- New postal vote applications (including proxies applying to vote by post), changes or cancellations to existing postal, postal proxy or proxy votes must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by 5 pm on Wednesday 19 June 2024. Applications can be made online at: https://www.gov.uk/applypostal-vote
- 8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's document valid for this election must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by 5 pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024. Applications can be made online at: https://www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate
- 9. New applications to vote by proxy (not postal proxy) at this election must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by 5 pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024. Applications can be made online at: https://www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote
- 10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election applied for on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by 5 pm on Thursday 4 July 2024. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024. To apply on the grounds of service/occupation or employment, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024.
