- 5. New applications for Voter Authority Certificates (VACs) at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at King's Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn PE30 1EX by **5 pm on Wednesday 6 November 2024**.
- 6. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at King's Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn PE30 1EX by 5 pm on Thursday 14 November 2024. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday 6 November 2024. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday 6 November 2024.
