- 1 The revised wording including the new emphasis on road-rail integration is very welcome.
- 2 It would assist the plan for further housing development at Hunstanton and for the local economy and air quality there and the North Norfolk coastal area and this particular rail to bus link should be highlighted as the first priority in the narrative and the second to be links from the Woottons and new housing development areas to the train station.
- 3 The inclusion of Lakenheath is obscure because, at present, tonly two trains a day stop there and on Saturday only. However, a revised train service with more trains stopping every day would certainly provide the basis for such a link from key rural service centres such as Feltwell and Methwold.
