In accordance with the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 the Borough Council of King's Lynn and West Norfolk is undertaking a Community Governance Review of the civil parish of Burnham Market.

The review seeks determine if the maximum number of parish councillors for Burnham Market Parish Council should be reduced from 11 to 8.

The Borough Council is conducting a consultation for the review process and is inviting local electors and any other party or body which appears to the Borough Council to have an interest in the review to submit their views.
